



Thessaloniki Mini City Tour

On Monday, September 7th, your official English-speaking guide will pick you up from hotel Makedonia Palace, at 09:00 to get you acquainted with the historic and beautiful city of Thessaloniki.

Driving along the University area we will reach the **Citadel and the city walls**, from where we can admire a marvelous panoramic view of Thessaloniki. Our next stop will be the **Church and Crypt of Agios Dimitrios**, one of the world’s largest caches of Byzantine architectural treasures. Following this great monument, we can then walk down the **Ancient Roman Market (Agora)**, cross the Egnatia street and reach **Aristotelous street**. We finally reach **Aristotelous square**, the key reference point of Thessaloniki.

Next stop will be the **White Tower**, symbol of Thessaloniki, built in the mid15th century (originally formed part of the city’s fortifications). Last but not least, we will admire the statue of **Alexander the Great**, who named this city after his sister, Thessaloniki. At this point, our mini city tour will come to an end. From Alexander the Great statue you can walk back to hotel Makedonia Palace or we can drive you there.
