A2. COURSE AVAILABILITY

There is a **limited number** of places offered in courses that include laboratory or bedside teaching.

Elective courses are **subject to demand** and a minimum number of enrolled students is required for to be organized in English.

A3. COURSE CONTENT AND ASSESSMENT

Clinical courses use a combination of lectures, seminars, and bedside teaching, with no option to separate components. Bedside teaching takes place in groups on the ward under the guidance of a doctor, covers the clinical component of teaching on relevant topics and alternates with lectures and seminars. At the end of the course, students will be assessed (written in multiple choice format, oral or oral-practical-skills exams).

A4. ORGANIZING YOUR LEARNING AGREEMENT

Depending on the period you wish to study at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, you should be focusing in

Winter semester: 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th and 9th semester courses

Spring semester: 2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th and 10th semester courses

Courses should correspond to the level of studies at your home university (courses from previous semesters may also be considered, however, **the possibility of timetable conflicts and overlaps should be taken into account, especially in courses with a significant workload**).

We expect our students to have a workload of

1 full academic year = 60 ECTS credits

1 semester = 30 ECTS credits

1 term/trimester = 20 ECTS credits

Applications are:

B. ARRIVING AT THE ARISTOTLE UNIVERSITY OF THESSALONIKI

Once you arrive at Aristotle University of Thessaloniki you need to register within the Erasmus Office (Department of European Educational Programs) where you will obtain your 'Erasmus ID' Card.

The next step is to visit the Secretariat of the School of Medicine, to be registered as a medical student - you will need your 'Erasmus ID' Card.

After completing registration procedures, you should meet the ECTS Coordinator who will inform you of the laboratories / hospitals your courses are taking place, assign you tutors and provide you with the relevant contact details.

If there is a compelling reason to make changes to your Learning Agreement (LA), they should be completed within the first month of your arrival.

Registration for the courses you are attending is done through the website <https://students.auth.gr/>. To register you will need to login with the username and password of your Institutional Account (AUTH e-mail account). In case you don't have an account please

consult the page: <https://it.auth.gr/en/Institutional-Account-Guide>. Remember to do this after finalization of any changes to your Learning Agreement (if needed). Please note that you will not be able to attend courses and take the exams /final evaluation without registration.
