7 rules suggested by the Advisors, standing for better organizing the Olympiads

- 1. **Date and Homepage**. The date for the forthcoming 5th International Medical Olympiad will be fixed as soon as the date of the European Congress of Nuclear Medicine will be announced. The date of the Olympiad will be included in the homepage of the Medical Olympicus Association. This homepage will be renewed with new information in about every 30 days.
- **2. International or European Points of Evaluation.** We are going to communicate with the IACME and ask information about the necessary procedures to follow in order to obtain international or European points of evaluation for those who will participate in the International Medical Olympiads. A similar action will be addressed through the Greek authorities to the European Union of Specialists for the same purpose.
- **3**. **Financial Benefits.** Provide benefits if financially possible, by partially waiving fees for participation, for housing and by offering financial support to travel expenses particularly for young colleagues, for colleagues from underdeveloped countries and for those having a high cost of travel.
- **4. Special Sessions.** Organize special sessions, before or after the main programme of oral presentations of the International Medical Olympiads like: a) A workshop about Statistics-Useful applications in Nuclear Medicine run by Prof S. Sharma and colleagues. b) Organize presentations on "how to" and/or "why" on practical subjects of social interest. c) Satellite sessions can be organized with or without the collaboration or sponsorship of pharmaceutical firms or Institutions.
- 5. Younger Colleagues. Try to communicate with younger colleagues through various local Medical Societies or by personal contact, in order to inform them of the benefits of the International Medical Olympiads sand invite them to participate. Advisors may be very helpful on this goal. Younger colleagues will also be encouraged to participate in the above special sessions, guided by senior colleagues, to the Organizing Committee of the International Medical Olympiads and in other parts of the programme. Younger colleagues may have financial support as mentioned above.
- **6. Constitutional Advisors.** We kindly mention to the constitutional Advisors that the position they hold in organizing the future Intern. Med. Olympiads is important and that they represent their Country. Their kind and voluntary contribution aims to submit original papers of social interest and to inform colleagues from their Countries of the benefits of the International Medical Olympiads, in case they wish to participate. Advisors may also wish to

propose to the Organizing Committee the names of certain distinguished colleagues for lecturers, may evaluate the papers submitted from their Country, suggest persons to participate to special sessions, or organize sessions, suggest chair-persons and also may wish to suggest who may receive financial support. All Advisors' suggestions will be duly considered for acceptance by the Organizing Committee.

7. A Sponsored Competition on a Special Subject. To encourage sponsors, Individuals, Institutions or Pharmaceutical Firms to sponsor under their name (like: the John Smith's award) a competition of original papers of social interest. Subjects of this competition could be: Alzheimer's Dementia, Lymphomas, Nanoparticles, Genetics etc. There will be a high financial prize for the winners of this contest and a small contribution to our Association for organizing the event.

In the 5th Medical Olympiad Professor Gurupad Bandopadhyaya from India and Professor Helmut Sinzinger from Austria will be named fellows of the International Medical Olympicus Association due to the distinguish prototype scientific contributions in Medicine and their great support to all Medical Olympics in the last 8 years. Professor Gurupad Bandopadhyaya and Professor Helmut Sinzinger will be awarded a golden medal and a diploma.

As in all previous Olympiads, three prizes, first, second and third will be awarded to the three best papers among all and will be accompanied by a diploma and a gift.

Accreditation points from EACCME

The number of such points to be given to the attendance of the Olympiad will be soon announced.

Registration

Registration fee for attending the programme of the Meeting and/or submitting a paper is 150€. At least one author for every paper submitted shall be registered. Participants may ask for a smaller registration fee. For young colleagues registration fee is 50€. Graduate and post graduate medical students, nurses and technicians: 40€. Students pay no fee.

For the workshop on Thursday, October 3^{rd} 2019, there must be an early registration because participants are limited to 45 only. All participants shall receive a booklet describing basic parts of the workshop lectures with examples at the beginning of this session. The price for the workshop is 50ϵ .

Participation to the daily excursion will be 20€ and lunch 10€.

Instructions for Abstracts

Deadline for submission of papers is **Monday, 16 September 2019**. Abstracts may be up to one and a half A4 page long, with borders of 2cm around the text and 1.5 distance between the lines, written in Times New Roman letters size 12, at any format, preferably the format of the *Hell J Nucl Med*, www.nuclmed.gr. Abstracts and whole papers may be published after the authors' consent, in the supplement of HJNM, I.F 1.008.

Criteria for the evaluation of papers *have been*: a) Originality on a new subject-basis: 40%, or on an existing concept: 30%, b) Social impact: 25%, c) Statistical support or sufficient proof of results: 25%, d) Well organized and easily read presentation: 10%.

The final programme-information's booklet will be distributed to the participants who are registered. This booklet will include: a) all necessary information about the 5th International Medical Olympiad, b) the abstracts of all papers orally presented with 2 questions and their answers given by the authors.

There will be only one invited lecture which will be presented on Saturday evening on the 5th of October 2019. Round tables or other lectures are not allowed in the Olympiads. A limited number of original posters may be allowed.

The Chairpersons of every session may have a few minutes to introduce the speakers. *The time allowed for every orally presented paper will be 15min and for discussion 5min. Authors are kindly requested to comply with this timetable.*
